WFTDA Committee
Definitions and Policies

Only WFTDA reps or recognized representatives of the GRG WFTDA committee are allowed to represent the league in WFTDA matters.

WFTDA Confidential GRG members may sign up on their dashboard account (WFTDA.com) to receive the WFTDA newsletter, the WFTDA Confidential.

WFTDA Representatives

This committee will try to staff 2 Skater Representatives and 1 Officials Representative. At this time, WFTDA allows up to 3 skater reps and 2 official reps. Representatives will have access to the WFTDA Forum and Sharepoint. Log-ins will not be shared by more than one person. Skater Reps, current or former skaters, will keep the league apprised of everything happening in WFTDA via the forum and bring all needed voting materials to the league. The Officials Rep, who may be a ref, NSO, or skater acting in an official capacity, will keep all the officials apprised of everything happening in the world of rules via the forum and also clarify rules questions via the forum.

Voting

For authorized WFTDA votes, the team will be polled on SurveyMonkey or any voting tool. The committee will assign one person the right to vote following the team majority. In the event of not having an assigned voter, the most senior member of the committee will do the voting. Since class status is tied to voting percentages, GRG should be as close to 100% in voting as possible.

Non-Disclosure Agreement Signatures (NDA)

GRG Skaters or Refs who have not signed the NDA a week before the WFTDA due date, June 30, will not be allowed to skate until they have signed. Skaters new to the league must sign the NDA at the same time they purchase insurance, by their third practice with GRG. They will not be allowed to skate the third practice without signing. NSOs must sign the NDA if they have access to our Skaters-Only page or conversations at practice. Breaking the NDA, no matter the size of the infringement, will be a Code of Conduct violation.

Charter

The Training Committee is responsible for defining who is on the charter. This committee may assist in transferring that information to WFTDA. Changes to the Charter must be turned over to WFTDA at least 30 days, to the hour, prior to when it is used.

Committee members or designated representatives may choose to attend the WFTDA Annual Meeting online.
